The Loyola Notre Dame Library can provide citation support in the following ways:

- Help patrons understand why citations are important, as per the Association of College & Research Libraries' [Framework for Information Literacy for Higher Education](#):

- Create and maintain an online citation help guide to the fundamental elements of a citation style
- Help patrons locate and navigate authoritative and comprehensive citation help guides from other institutions
- Help patrons access and navigate [Zotero](#), a free citation management tool
- Discuss any *specific* fundamental elements of a citation style in a course-integrated library instruction session where the focus is primarily on library research, or in a research consultation (e.g., understanding and locating a DOI)

The Library will not provide the following types of citation assistance:

- General workshops, entire course-integrated library instruction sessions, or individual or group consultations focusing solely on citations
- Proofreading citations
